

Double Trouble Floss

Preparation:

Alphabetic Principle of the FLOSS rule:

- FLOSS Rule: when you hear /f/, /l/, /s/, or /z/ after a short vowel sound at the end of a one-syllable word, then you double the ending letters. (buff, tell, miss, buzz)
- Code with a star over \bigstar double letters.
- The letter z is sometimes doubled but not always.
- Exceptions: plus, bus, if, yes, this, gas, us, all

Materials:

Copy, laminate, and cut the FLOSS - word bank. Copy the two-column sorting mat. Paper and pencil

Directions:

- 1. Sort the words according to the FLOSS Rule.
- 2. Record your answers on recording sheet.
