
## **Compare and Contrast**



## **Procedure for Teaching Compare and Contrast**

- 1. Teacher defines the concept of compare.
  - Ex: "Comparing is telling how two objects are alike."
- 2. Teacher defines the concept of contrast.
  - Ex: "Contrast is telling how two objects are different."
- 3. Teacher explains how being able to compare and contrast helps the reader see the similarities and differences between two things in a story.
- 4. Model compare and contrast using a **T** chart or Venn diagram.
  - Use examples of something familiar and common to students to activate schema about comparisons and contrasts, such as two fruits or two students in the room.
- 5. Model teaching compare and contrast with a text.
- 6. Provide guided practice in applying compare and contrast by completing a graphic organizer.
