Echo Reading

Purpose: Improve accuracy, rate and prosody by modeling what fluent reading sounds like and have students imitate it

Procedure:

- 1. The reader (usually the teacher) reads the first line of a the text orally, stressing appropriate rate and prosody.
- 2. Have students read the same line immediately following the reader's example.
- 3. The reader and students continue reading the entire passage in this echo fashion.
- 4. Increase the amount of text read at a time as students become more proficient readers.

Materials:

 Teacher and student copies of a text at their independent or instructional level.

Adaptation:

If students are unable to read a full line of material, make necessary adjustments. For example, students may start by hearing and reading words or phrases and gradually increase to hearing and reading complete sentences.
