

FLOSS Time

Preparation:

Alphabetic Principle of the FLOSS rule:

- FLOSS Rule: When you hear /f/, /l/, /s/, or /z/ after a short vowel sound at the end of a one-syllable word, then you double the ending letters. (buff, tell, miss, buzz)
- Code it with a star over double letters
- The letter z is sometimes doubled but not always.
- Exceptions: plus, bus, if, yes, this, gas, us, all

Materials:

Copy FLOSS word bank on cardstock, laminate, and cut.

Copy the sorting mat.

Paper and pencil

Directions:

- 1. Sort the words according to the FLOSS Rule using the mat.
- 2. Record your answers on recording sheet.
